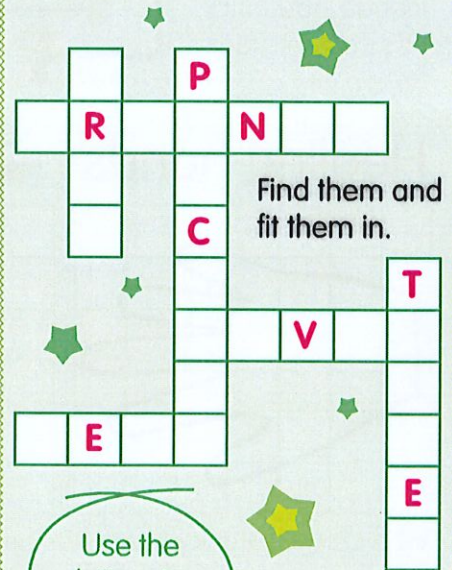
JESUS IS GREAT

Jesus' friends travelled with him. Unscramble the names to see who they are.

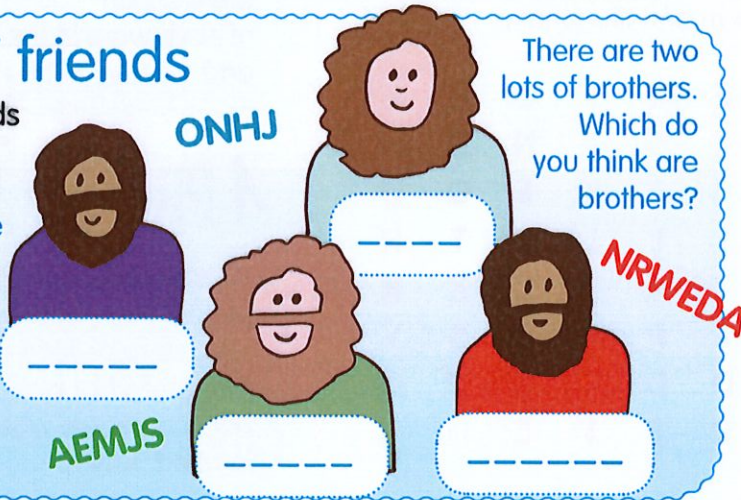
